# Pneuma (pneu-ma)

(n) Greek for the Holy Spirit

#### "Pneuma"



Pneuma comes from a Greek word that means literally 'that which is breathed or blown'. In the Bible, it is used of the Holy Spirit or "Breath of heaven". In Romans 8:1-27, this passage uses Pneuma 19 times in reference to the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit is the third head of the triune God – God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit. But the Holy Spirit is the one that

is often misunderstood, feared, and in some cases dismissed as irrelevant.

Who is the Holy Spirit? Is He a force like in Star Wars? How does the Holy Spirit communicate? What is His role? Should the Holy Spirit be feared? Should the way the Holy Spirit shows Himself be feared? Why is the Holy Spirit important? How does the Holy Spirit interact with God? With Jesus? How does the Holy Spirit interact with the world? Does the Holy Spirit communicate to non-Christians? What is the Holy Spirit's impact on the church? What happened at Pentecost? Does the Holy Spirit ever say anything that is contrary to what the Bible teaches? Is the Holy Spirit still giving spiritual gifts to followers of Jesus today?

So many questions and, unfortunately, followers of Jesus and even pastors don't want to talk to Him. Sometimes the Holy Spirit is treated like a rebellious child in some church traditions. It creates fear or skepticism like the study of the supernatural or ghosts does to some people. In this series, we will try to answer these questions and more as we dig into what the Bible teaches about the Holy Spirit and His involvement with Jesus, the Bible, the church, the world, and followers of Jesus.
