"Signs: Be Watchful" Article



I sit here at my desk and I'm reading about political upheaval, rising unemployment rates, riots, COVID-19, hurricanes, and wildfires. I can't help but wonder . . . is this the end times? Is Jesus coming back soon? Are we ready?

The Bible gives us signs signaling Jesus' return but they're confusing. In Matthew 24, the disciples came to Jesus and asked

him what were the signs of His coming and the end of the age? His answer can be difficult to interpret and understand; and people have been trying to predict His return for generations . . . unsuccessfully. Thankfully, Jesus also gave the disciples clear, practical guidance about how to prepare for His return.

In today's world it is easy to miss signs. We are busy, pressed for time, trying to survive each day. Signs can be all around us, but we simply don't see them.

This series is to wake us up, to open our eyes to see the signs. It is not about trying to predict the hour of Jesus' return. It is about being ready – preparing for and following Jesus' advice and instructions on what to do when we see them.

With enlightenment comes responsibility. There are things that God wants us to do before He sends Jesus back to rapture His followers. Let's watch for the signs and, more importantly, let's live obedient, faithful lives as we see the signs emerge.
